

MoT Approves INR 100cr CFA Under Phase II Of Swadesh Darshan Scheme For Goa

The Union Ministry of Tourism (MoT) has approved the allocation of INR 100 crore to Government of Goa under the Swadesh Darshan Scheme. A Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) formed by the Department of Tourism under the Goa Tourism Development Corporation (GTDC) made a detailed presentation before the Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee after which the project was approved under Phase II for Coastal Circuit Development in the state. Projects have been envisaged all along the South Goa coastline. However some of the key coastal areas like Dona Paula, Miramar, Colva, Benaulim and Palolem will get a facelift since they get a major footfall. Some of the components include providing basic amenities of toilets, lighting, tourist facilitation centres, CCTVs, GIS systems, and beautification.
