ORDER

Subject: - Restrictive order “Levels of Restrictions for Breaking the Chain” of Corona Virus (Covid-19) infection.

Whereas, vide the orders at the above Reference No. 4, the State Government has issued measures and guidelines

for restricting the spread of Covid-19 disease in Maharashtra State.

Whereas, with a view to contain the spread of Covid-19 in the State, the Government has issued revised order for district wise/ administrative unit wise relaxation of the restrictions imposed to effectively break the chain of spread and to systematically open the various financial and social undertakings.

Whereas, with a view to contain and restrict the infectious disease Covid-19 arisen on account of Corona Virus in the State, the Maharashtra Covid-19 Measures Policy 2020 has come into force under the aforesaid Act. Under the Maharashtra Covid-19 Measures Policy 2020, the Commissioner, Pune Municipal Corporation has been authorized for taking measures to contain the spread of Covid-19 within Pune Municipal Corporation areas. The Average Positivity Rate of Covid-19 is 6.11% and Oxygen Bed Occupancy is 27.47 in Pune Municipal Corporation areas. In pursuance thereof, as per the powers conferred on me under the Epidemic Diseases Act 1897 and the Disaster Management Act 2005, **I, Vikram Kumar, Commissioner**, Pune Municipal Corporation, issue the following revised order to contain the spread of Covid-19 within Pune Municipal Corporation areas.

1) Essential services (Essential Category) will include the following services.

- Hospitals, diagnostic centres, clinics, vaccination, medical insurance offices, pharmacies and pharmaceutical companies, other medical and health services, supporting manufacturing and distribution units and their dealers, transportation and supplying establishments, vaccinations, sanitizers, masks, medical materials and instruments, raw materials manufacturers and suppliers and all the services pertaining thereto.
- Veterinary hospitals, Pet Animal Research Centre, pet animal foods shops.
- Works concerning forestation as declared by the Forest Department.
- Airways services and services pertaining thereto (Airlines, airports, maintenance, cargo, ground services, catering, fueling, security, etc.)
- Groceries, vegetable, fruit vendors, shops of dairy, bakery, sweets and all kinds of food items, shops selling mutton, chicken, eggs, fish.
- Cold Storage and Warehousing.
- Public transport – taxi, rickshaw, railways, airway, public bus.

- Office of Consulates of different countries.
- Pre-monsoon planning works.
- Public services provided by the local authorities.
- Reserve Bank of India and the essential services declared by it.
- SEBI and offices of SEBI and offices providing services pertaining to it (Stock Exchange, Depositories and Clearing Corporation and intermediaries registered with SEBI).
- Telephone service and maintenance and repair services pertaining thereto.
- Goods transportation.
- Water supply service.
- Agriculture related services and establishments pertaining thereto (seeds, fertilizer, instruments and maintenance and repair, etc. services pertaining thereto).
- All kinds of exports-imports.
- E-commerce (for supply of goods and services of essential services).
- Recognized media.
- Petrol pumps and services supplying petroleum related products (including offshore/onshore production).
- All kinds of cargo/courier services.

- Data centres/Cloud Services/Information and Technology related basic facilities and services.
- Government and public security services.
- Electricity and gas supply services.
- ATMs
- Postal service.
- Ports and the undertakings pertaining thereto.
- Customs house agents, authorized licensed multimodal transport operators transporting vaccinations/ medicines/ life saving medicines.
- Manufacturers/suppliers of raw materials, packaging materials for any essential services.
- Manufacturers of the materials for monsoon disturbances for the citizens or institutions.
- Essential services declared by the Disaster Management Authority.

2) Exempted establishments/services (Exemption Category)

A) Offices –

The following offices in Pune Municipal Corporation area will remain open.

- Offices of central, state, public self-government agencies (including Statutory Authorities and organizations).
 - Co-operative banks, public banks, private banks.
 - Offices of the companies providing essential services.
 - Insurance/Mediclaim companies.
 - Medicine manufacturing establishments and manufacturers of the equipments required for the same and the offices pertaining thereto.
 - Institutions under the control of Reserve Bank of India (Standalone Primary dealers, CCIL, NPCL, Payment System Operator and partnership units and intermediaries in the financial markets operating in the market places regularized by Reserve Bank).
 - All non-banking financial corporations.
 - All micro finance institutions.
 - Offices of the advocates, C.A.s, offices of financial institutions.
- 3) All the shops mentioned in the essential services (essential category) within Pune Municipal Corporation areas will remain open all weak days upto 04.00 pm.

- 4) Non-essential shops will remain open from Monday to Friday upto 04.00 pm. They will remain fully closed on Saturdays and Sundays.
- 5) Malls, cinema houses (single screen and Multiplex), theatres will remain fully closed.
- 6) Restaurants, bars, food courts will remain open from Monday to Friday upto 4.00 pm with 50% seating capacity. After 4.00 pm and on Saturdays and Sundays, parcel service (take away)/home delivery service only will remain open upto 11.00 pm.
- 7) Employees of medical services, essential services and women, government servants and employees of airport services, port services only will be permitted to travel by local train.
- 8) Public places (gardens), open ground, walking and cycling in Pune Municipal Corporation areas will remain open all week days from 05.00 am to 09.00 am.
- 9) Except the exempted establishments/services (Exemption Category), all private offices will remain open upto 04.00 pm on working days with 50% capacity of employees.

- 10) Government offices and emergency services required for Covid-19 Management in Pune Municipal Corporation areas will remain open with 100% capacity.

Government offices (other than the offices working for emergency/ Corona) will remain open with presence of 50% officers/staff. If the aforesaid offices/ establishments required presence of staff members more than that, then the establishments concerned shall obtain permission of the Disaster Management Authority.

- 11) All outdoor sports (games) will remain open all days from 05.00 am to 09.00 am.
- 12) Social, religious programs and entertainment programs will be permitted with the presence of 50 people upto 04.00 pm from Monday to Friday.
- 13) Marriage ceremony programs will be permitted to be performed with the presence of maximum 50 people.
- 14) Funeral, obsequial ceremony and the programs pertaining thereto will be permitted to be performed with the presence of maximum 20 people.
- 15) Various meetings, assemblies, General Body meetings, elections of local bodies and co-operative societies will be permitted to be held with 50% presence.

- 16) Construction work will be kept open in Pune Municipal Corporation areas at such construction sites where provision for residence of the workers is available. However, where the workers are coming from outside, the construction work will be permitted to be carried out upto 04.00 pm. The workers coming from outside will leave at 04.00 pm to go to home from there.
- 17) Agriculture sector related shops and the establishments pertaining thereto (seeds, fertilizer, instruments and maintenance and repair services, etc. pertaining thereto) and the shops/galas selling agricultural produces in Agriculture Produce Committee will remain open upto 04.00 pm on all days of week.
- 18) E-Commerce services will be permitted to supply all goods and services.
- 19) Assembly/Gathering of more than 5 people upto 5.00 pm in Pune Municipal Corporation areas will be banned and after 05.00 pm section 144 (curfew) is being put in force.
- 20) Gyms, saloons, beauty parlours, spas, wellness centres will remain open at 50% seating capacity by appointment upto 04.00 pm. However, Air Conditioners cannot be used at such places.

- 21) Public transport management in Pune Municipal Corporation areas (PMPML) will continue to operate with 50% seating capacity (without standing).
- 22) Vehicles transporting goods with maximum three persons therein (driver + cleaner + helper) will be permitted to travel as per the rules applicable to other passengers.
- 23) Inter district travel by private vehicles, buses and long distance trains will be permitted. However, if the vehicles are going to have halts at the places declared at Level 5 by the Government, then it shall be mandatory to have e-pass. At such time, separate e-pass for each person travelling in the vehicle will be necessary.
- 24) Manufacturing in export oriented units (including MSMEs that need to fulfill export obligation) will continue regularly.
- 25) Following manufacturing areas/industries will remain open regularly.
 - A) Essential goods manufacturing units – (with the units manufacturing raw materials required by essential goods manufacturing industries, units packaging the same and complete supply chain).
 - B) All continuous process industries – (Units that require process that are of such a nature that these

cannot be stopped immediately and cannot restart without considerable time requirement).

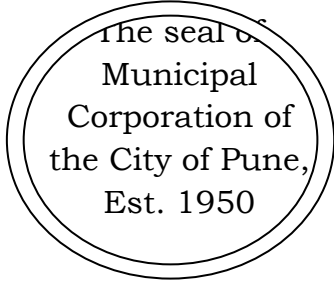
- C) Manufacturing of items that are significant to National Security and Defence.
 - D) Data Centres/Cloud Service Providers/IT Service supporting critical infrastructure and services.
- 26) All the manufacturing areas other than those mentioned at above Paragraph Nos. 24 and 25 will remain open with 50% capacity of employees. The industry concerned shall make separate transport arrangement for transit of employees. The said employees cannot travel by public transport system.
- 27) The employees working at the places of establishments permitted in the above order to remain open upto 04.00 pm and the public availing of the services from such places are expected to return to their homes by 05.00 pm.
- 28) The regular classes of all primary, secondary schools, colleges, educational institutions will fully remain closed upto the date 30th June, 2021. However, online education will be permitted. All kinds of coaching classes will fully remain closed.

- 29) Liquor vend shops will remain open upto 04.00 pm from Monday to Friday. Home delivery facility will remain available on Saturdays and Sundays.
- 30) The above order shall also be applicable to Pune Cantonment Board and Khadki Cantonment Board falling within Pune Municipal Corporation areas.
- 31) Orders/guidelines issued from time to time vide the orders referred to above will remain in force till the further order.
- 32) The above order has been passed by taking into consideration the Level decided by Government as per the Covid-19 Average Positivity Rate and Oxygen Bed Occupancy in Pune Municipal Corporation areas. If any rise/reduction is found therein, revised order will be issued by reviewing the same.

Person violating orders, guidelines issued from time to time by this Office to contain Covid-19 shall be liable to action under sections 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and section 188 of the Indian Penal Code and other legal provisions.

Above order shall remain in force in Pune Municipal Corporation areas from the date 07.06.2021 till further order.
