

Hotel Industry Opposes To Serving Food By Weight

HRAWI has approached Gujarat high court, opposing the demand that they serve food by weight and not per dish or serving. The Mumbai-based association has filed an application in the High Court, asserting that the demand to serve food by weight is not correct because there are different prices and standards for food at different eateries.

The opposition came through after a Vadodara-based NGO, Gujarat Khedut Hit Rakshak Samiti, filed the petition demanding implementation of the Standards of Weights and Measures Act in the serving of food at eateries. It urged the court to force hotels and restaurants to serve food and beverages in standard measures and charge customers accordingly. It held that the practice of serving and charging for food by the dish/serving is a concept alien to law.
