**(UNDER THE SECTION 144 OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE 1973)**

Whereas, in exercise of the powers, conferred under the Disaster Management Act 2005, the Hon. Chairperson, State Executive Committee & Chief Secretary Government of Maharashtra has issued order dated 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 and 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 (extended by order dated 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2020, 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2020 and 29<sup>th</sup> December, 2020, 29<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 and 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2021, 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2021, 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 and 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2021, 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2021, 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2021, 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2021, 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2021, 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2021, 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2021, 12<sup>th</sup> May, 2021, 30<sup>th</sup> May 2021 for containment of COVID -19 in the State and issued revised guidelines by including certain activities from time to time vide above mentioned orders,

And whereas, Government of Maharashtra vide its order dated 04/06/2021 which is referred at Sr. No. 04 has decided to impose various levels of restrictions in different parts of state based on the conditions in each respective district/administrative unit to not only break the chain of transmission effectively but also to commence disciplined restart of various economic & social activities without forgoing the gains achieved in controlling the spread of Covid-19 infections through measures of restrictions.

Whereas, Government of Maharashtra has also decided by said referred order dated 04/06/2021, to apply level of restrictions based on two parameters: case positively rate and percentages of oxygen bed occupancy.

And whereas, Nagpur district on basis of two criteria's i.e. case positively rate & percentages of oxygen bed occupancy, falls under **level 1** category as positively rate is below 5% & Oxygen Beds occupancy is less than 25%.

And whereas, in its meeting dated 06/06/2021 District Disaster Manager Authority, Nagpur has decided to impose certain additional restrictions to the order of Government of Maharashtra dated 04/06/2021 meant for level 1 category to contain the spread of Corona virus.

Therefore, in exercise of the powers, conferred under section 2 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 and The Disaster Management Act, 2005, in the capacity as Chairperson, **I, Ravindra Thakare, Collector & District Magistrate, Nagpur**, hereby issue the order imposing following guidelines/ restrictions about

the various activities. This order will remain in force throughout the Nagpur District (Excluding the area of Nagpur Municipal Corporation, Nagpur) from 7 AM on 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2021.

**Note:**

1. **“Regular”** means normal ways of transaction with Covid Appropriate Behavior restrictions and subject to any SOP that may be promulgated by State Disaster Management Authority for various activities.
2. All other activities/conditions other than the ones specified in this order will be in accordance with the previous orders issued earlier by this office and orders under reference.
3. If any person / establishment doesn't follow the Covid Appropriate Behavior (Wearing of Mask, Maintaining Social Distancing ,etc) properly or doesn't adhere to the directions/ guidelines maintained in this order, will be liable for strict punishments under Disaster Management Act 2005, Epidemic Disease Act of 1897 and section 188 of IPC Act of 1860. Fines and Penalties will be imposed on the defaulters as per the orders mentioned in references. Offender's licenses or permissions of establishments will be withdrawn for operations till notification for Covid-19 epidemic, remains in force.
4. Every Thursday review of parameters, (I) Positivity Rate and (II) Occupancy of Oxygenated Beds, would be done. Based on these parameters, level of restrictions, would be decided and new order would be issued on every Friday, which would come in force from Monday.

**The said order will remain in force throughout the Nagpur District ( Excluding the area of Nagpur Municipal Corporation, Nagpur) from 7 AM on 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2021, till 07.00 am of 14<sup>th</sup> June 2021.**
