MAHARASHTRA PROHIBITION ACT, 1949.

No. BPA.112022 / 2022-23 / 216 / VII.— In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of Rule 4 of the Maharashtra Potable Liquor (Periodicity and Fees for Grant, Renewal or Continuance of Licence) Rules, 1996 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf and in consonance with the direction issued by the Government *vide* letter No. BPA 0122 / CR – 10 / EXC-2, dated 25th March 2022 the Commissioner is hereby pleased to renotify the rates of licence fees for the year 2022-2023 only for the licences mentioned in Column No. (2) of the schedule appended hereto as specified against each of them respectively in Column No. (4) of the said schedule :—
