ORDER

Subject:- Levels of Restrictions for Breaking the Chain.

Whereas the Government of Maharashtra, in exercise of the power conferred under section 2, 3, & 4 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 has framed Regulations for prevention of containment of COVID-19 under Notification No. Corona 2020/CR/58/Aarogya-5 dated 13th March 2020 and Dated 14th March 2020.



And Whereas, as per rule 3 of the said Regulation, Municipal Commissioner of Municipal Corporation has been declared as 'Empowered officer' & is empowered to take such measures as are necessary to prevent the outbreak of Covid-19 or spread thereof within his respective jurisdiction,

Whereas, Government of Maharashtra vide its order dt. 04.06.2021 which is referred at Sr.No. 07 has decided to impose various levels of restrictions in different parts of State based on the conditions in each respective district/ administrative unit to not only break the chain of transmission effectively but also to commence disciplined restart of various economic & social activities without forgoing the gains achieved in controlling the spread of Covid-19 infections through measures of restrictions.

Whereas Government of Maharashtra also declare Nagpur Municipal corporation as a separate administrative unit for framing effective measures of restrictions for containment of Covid-19 pandemic.

Whereas Government of Maharashtra has also decided by said referred order dt. 04.06.2021, to apply level of restrictions based on two parameters i.e. Case Positivity Rate & Percentages of Oxygen Bed Occupancy.

And Whereas Nagpur Municipal Corporation on the basis of these two criteria i.e. Case Positivity Rate & Percentage of Oxygen Bed Occupancy, falls under **level 1** category as on 04.06.2021 as positivity rate is below 5% & Oxygen Beds occupancy is less than 25%, which is subject to review on Thursday of each week; as declared by authority.

Whereas, looking at the past experiences, and also the traditions in the Nagpur City, about overcrowding in various gatherings (Social/Cultural/Entertainment, Marriages, Funeral etc. and also in Markets) the District Disaster Management Authority in Consultation with State Authority, in the interest of safety of life of public at large felt it necessary to put some restriction though city comes in level 1 about maximum number of persons to remain present in such events & also regarding timing as per Annexure "A".

And therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under Rule 3 of the "The Maharashtra COVID-19 Regulation, 2020" and of all other powers enabling in that behalf, in the interest of safety of life of public at large, I, Radhakrishnan B., Municipal Commissioner Nagpur Municipal Corporation hereby direct that, said Government of Maharashtra order dtd. 04.06.2021 as referred at Sr.No. 7 shall be implement in the city

of Nagpur (Nagpur Municipal Corporation Area) with restrictions / guidelines about various activities as per **Annexure A**; subject to guidelines & directions which will be issued by Government of Maharashtra from time to time.

This is also clarified that "Regular" means normal ways of transactions with Covid appropriate behavior restrictions, such as but not limited to Use of Face masks, Social Distancing, Use of Sanitizers etc. and subject to any SOP that may be promulgated by State disaster management authority / Nagpur Municipal Corporation for various activities, failing to follow concern SOP will leads to sealing of shops / activities also with fines. It is also directed that the activities which has not been covered in Annexure A, will apply existing restrictions as per Nagpur Municipal Corporation's earlier Order.

This order will come into force in the limit of Nagpur Municipal Corporation area from Monday 7th June 2021.
