

BMC extends date for placing of Marathi signboards at shops in Mumbai

The Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) has extended the deadline for placing Marathi signboards at all shops and establishments in Mumbai to June 30. The civic body had earlier given a date for changing of the sign boards by May 31. However, officials said that following requests from traders the same was extended to June 30.

This civic order comes after the state cabinet earlier this year approved the amendment to the Maharashtra Shops and Establishments (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 2017, so that the shops and establishments with even less than 10 workers will have to display Marathi nameplates.
