



HOTEL BODY URGES MAHA GOVT TO ROLL BACK 5% VAT HIKE

urged the Maharashtra government to roll back the 5% increase in Value Added Tax (VAT) on liquor served at bars and restaurants across the state. On October 22, the Maharashtra government raised VAT for permit room liquor service by 5%, resulting in a new total rate of 10%, according to the state government notification.
