

Get set for IndiaSkills 2024 Hospitality Competitions

The Tourism & Hospitality Skill Council (THSC) is gearing up to host the IndiaSkills 2024 Hospitality Competitions, a three-day event taking place from April 27 to 29 at the Institute of Bakery and Culinary Arts and Hotel Saket 27 in New Delhi. This event holds a significant place in the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship's IndiaSkills 2023–24 program, spotlighting emerging talent across five key hospitality disciplines: bakery, cooking, restaurant services, patisserie and confectionery, and hotel reception.

Competitors from all corners of the country have competed for the chance to participate in the IndiaSkills Track-II Competitions 2024 in Delhi. Following a rigorous selection process, involving MCQ-based assessments and practical competitions, 194 candidates have been shortlisted for the five hospitality skills. A distinguished panel of industry experts from leading colleges, academies, and institutions will evaluate the participants, ensuring a comprehensive and impartial assessment process.
