

Lemon Tree Hotels signs two new Maharashtra resorts

New resorts in Tadgaon and Igatpuri strengthen the company's presence in emerging leisure destinations

Lemon Tree Hotels Limited has announced the signing of two new resort properties — Lemon Tree Resort, Tadgaon and Lemon Tree Resort, Igatpuri — as part of its expansion strategy in western India.
