Additional 100k–150k skilled workers needed annually in hospitality sector: Mr. Pradeep Shetty at FHRAI's HR Summit

Referring to the manpower shortage in the Indian hospitality sector at the FHRAI'S HR Summit, Mr. Pradeep Shetty, VP, FHRAI said that many skilled employees have exited the industry after the COVID-19 pandemic. "A workforce gap remains, with an estimated need for an additional 100,000-150,000 skilled workers annually," he said, adding that with projections for India's hospitality industry to nearly double by 2029, reaching an estimated value of \$475.37 billion, we have tremendous growth potential.
