By investing in sustainable infrastructure, we are addressing plastic waste at its source—without compromising guest comfort, operational efficiency or service excellence. Each bottle follows a controlled cleaning, sterilisation and refilling process, ensuring consistency, safety and reliability at every touchpoint.

For corporate clients and event planners, it reinforces our ability to support responsible, sustainability-led events aligned with evolving global expectations.
